




Great Lakes-St. Lawrence Legislative Caucus (GLLC)

- Members are eligible for travel scholarship while available







- MN H.F.1109/S.F.608 (introduced): Prohibits data centers outside of industrial zones
- MN H.F. 1150 (introduced): Funds study of environmental impacts of AI
- IN S.B.0431 (passed first chamber): Restricts foreignowned companies from constructing data centers in Indiana
- IN H.C.0003 (enacted): Urges reforms to expedite approval of transmission projects to meet data center demand
- MI H.B.4085 (introduced): Restrict data centers to industrial zones
- IL S.B.2181 (introduced): Requires data centers annually report energy and water usage to the Illinois Power Agency
- IL S.B.0094 (introduced): Prohibits foreign companies from constructing data centers in Illinois
