## Resolution Supporting the Agreement to Reduce Phosphorus in Western Lake Erie

WHEREAS, in the summer of 2014, the city of Toledo, Ohio, experienced a three-day ban on

the use of drinking water due to the presence of algal blooms; and

WHEREAS, phosphorous runoff has been attributed to encouraging the growth of harmful algal

blooms; and

**WHEREAS,** Ontario, Michigan, and Ohio have agreed to reduce phosphorous in the western

basin of Lake Erie by 40 percent over the next ten years and have set an interim goal of a 20-percent reduction in phosphorous by the year 2020; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED,** that the Great Lakes Legislative Caucus encourages support for the agreement

reached between Ontario, Michigan, and Ohio regarding the reduction of

phosphorous in the Lake Erie western basin; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that this resolution be submitted to the governors and premiers, the legislative

majority and minority leaders, and the government house leaders of the Great

Lakes states and provinces.
