Dear Mr. President:

We write to you today as members of the Great Lakes Legislative Caucus (GLLC), a nonpartisan, binational group of legislators from the eight states and two Canadian provinces that are home to the Great Lakes. We are dismayed at the proposal in your March 16 Budget Blueprint to eliminate the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI). This action will significantly damage the economic and environmental well-being of the Great Lakes Region. The GLRI is absolutely critical to maintaining the environmental and economic health of the Great Lakes, which provide 84% of North America's fresh surface water and create millions of family-supporting jobs for Americans and Canadians. As Great Lakes legislators, we urge you to restore the GLRI and to fund the program at \$300 million annually as authorized by the 114th Congress in 2016.

The value of the Great Lakes as a resource is dependent upon stopping invasive species from entering the lakes and decimating our native species; addressing the conditions contributing to the growth of harmful algal blooms, which make water unsafe for drinking and swimming; and cleaning up sites contaminated by toxic pollutants from this region's industrial legacy. Funding under the GLRI is responsible for three polluted sites in Michigan and Pennsylvania being completely restored, while significant progress has been made at another 13 sites in those states as well as Wisconsin, Indiana, Ohio, New York, and Illinois. These are real, well-documented results of the GLRI. The incredible environmental recovery of the Great Lakes, and the economic benefit to coastal communities that result from this environmental restoration, will <u>not</u> continue without the projects enabled by the GLRI. Simply put, eliminating the GLRI throws the continued economic and environmental viability of the Great Lakes Region into grave jeopardy. It would also undermine the efforts of both Canada and the United States to meet their commitments, as expressed in the 2012 Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement.

Eliminating the GLRI also will deal a tremendous blow to strong efforts by state and local governments to protect Great Lakes resources and maintain important wildlife habitats. These programs benefit greatly from the strategic planning and resources provided by the GLRI. Many state and local programs may simply cease to function without the coordination and support of the GLRI, which has enjoyed tremendous support across party lines since its inception. In addition to the overwhelmingly negative impacts on the Great Lakes economy and ecosystem, eliminating funding for the GLRI will cause direct and immediate harm to human health in the Great Lakes Region. A workforce that does not have reliable access to clean, safe drinking water cannot hope to thrive or reach its full potential.

Eliminating GLRI funding will cause massive and lasting damage to the economy and environment of the Great Lakes Region. We, the undersigned legislators, urge you to reconsider and reject a course of action that could undo decades of necessary improvements to North America's most precious natural resource.
